A critical moment for action

Handwashing with soap is one of the principal actions we can all take to protect the health of ourselves and our communities.

It is particularly vital in combatting the spread of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19).

However, communities around the world also suffer the devastating effects of many other diseases, most notably gastrointestinal illness.

Yet in many parts of the world people don't have access to basic handwashing facilities at home or in public places. Often, this is because handwashing facilities are not easy to deploy, appealing to use, nor sufficiently durable.

Jengu was developed as an opensource design by leading engineers, humanitarians and behavioural psychologists. The unit requires no plumbing, so it can be moved and placed at the point of need; and its engaging features make handwashing a pleasant experience.

Alderman Tooling is proud to have been the product development partner for Jengu. We produced the metal parts for the original prototype units and the first production run, and have worked closely with the Arup engineers to optimise the design for manufacture.

Handwashing for everyone, everywhere

With the COVID-19 pandemic, regular handwashing is paramount for everyone – not just in humanitarian settings.

As businesses, schools, events and venues in the UK begin to return to normal, everyone needs to work together to stay safe and prevent infection.

It is vital that organisations and community leaders show a duty of care, and provide a safe environment for community members, service users and staff.

Extra hand washing facilities are a visible reminder to everyone of the importance of good hygiene.

Aldermans has developed the Jengu Hygiene unit specifically for wider use in the UK.

Jengu can be placed indoors or outdoors, wherever people need to wash their hands.

- Schools and colleges. With Jengu, students can wash their hands near their classrooms, without leaving their designated areas or bubbles.
- **Campsites.** Campsite owners can place Jengu units close to pitches, to ensure guests have safe, clean hand washing facilities close by.
- Outdoor venues and attractions. Attractions can place Jengu units strategically throughout their site, to enhance existing facilities and encourage regular hand washing.

Easy and fun to use, robust yet lightweight and portable - Jengu Hygiene is ideal for all these locations, and more.

Mirror: Large and robust, won't flake or crack. Increases face and eye hygiene and makes people want to spend more time at washing their hands.

Pump dispenser for liquid soap.

Tap: Shaped for handwashing, and to deter other uses.

Bar soap (option):

Can be drilled and secured with a wire cable.


Strong, durable, stainless steel riveted assembly.

Disc feet give stability on any surface and prevent sinking into soft ground.

Foot pump reduces the likelihood of hand re-contamination. Soft rubber – can be used with or without shoes, and by all ages.

Basin: Plastic or stainless steel.

Water and waste containers, plus pipes.



Security fixing: Holes in the legs enable the units to be anchored to the ground or connected together.

Mirror: Slim yet robust, this encourages people to spend time handwashing, and makes using the sink enjoyable.

Basin: Robust, fixed plastic basin with drainage hole.

Security fixing:

Holes in the legs enable the units to be anchored to the ground or connected together.


> Domed rubber feet are anti-slip and will not scratch flooring.

> > Foot pump. Easy to use and reduces the likelihood of hand re-contamination.

Tap: Shaped to optimise water flow and deter other uses (eg, filling drinking bottles).

Flat packed for easy self-assembly and compact storage (screw-fixed legs, allen head screws and tools provided). Stainless steel construction.

Water and waste containers, plus pipes.

We were delighted to trial the Aldermans portable sinks in our Junior School when pupils returned during the Summer Term. With schools becoming one of the first places to reopen after lockdown, it was incredibly important to maintain hygiene levels in all the year group 'bubbles' and being able to easily install additional handwashing stations around the buildings and external areas was a vital factor in protecting our school community.

Our students quickly got to grips with using the foot pump and having a hands-free solution was extremely beneficial by reducing the risk of infection at a crucial time for the school. In fact, for many of our students washing their hands became a socially fun experience and they really enjoyed using the sinks! Equally, to have portable devices allowed us to quickly and relatively effortlessly relocate them should the need arise.

With government guidelines suggesting that schools will be returning in full capacity for the Autumn Term, these sinks will inevitably prove to be an invaluable tool in ensuring high hygiene levels are maintained, therefore we would recommend them for any setting looking to supplement their own wash facilities in an affordable and efficient manner.
